All brackets designed and sold by RioOutdoors.com are to be used for building pergolas only and are not to be used for other structure construction purposes.





2.1 SAFETY INFORMATION



3 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


3.1 CREATING THE STARTER RAFTERS ASSEMBLY

Locate one (1) Octagon Spider Bracket, #O-SPD, and two (2) rafter members with the Octagon Cross Tie Brackets and Octagon Roof Skirt Tie Bracket installed on them.


The Starter Rafters Assembly is the last on-ground assembly that must be created. Once this assembly is created and installed on top of the octagon base structure, the installation of the remaining rafters will be super-simplified.




- 1. With the cross tie brackets at the bottom, slide the straight cut end of one rafter (A) inside one rafter U-Channel of the Octagon Spider Bracket. If the rafter is a tight fit in the U-channel, tap top surface of the rafter with a hammer to help it slide in.
- 2. Butt the straight cut end in the rafter member against the "Straight Cut Stop" face.




- 3. Flip the spider and rafter assembly upside down to expose two lag screw holes at the bottom of the rafter U-channel.
- 4. While pushing the rafter firmly against the "Straight Cut Stop," drill 3/32" x 1-1/4" pilot holes at the center of the two holes.




5. Drive one $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1-1/4" lag screw through both pilot holes you drilled. Tighten the lag screws.




6. Identify 7/16" hole on the left side of the Rafter U-Channel. Drill a 3/32" x 1-1/4" pilot hole at the center of this hole.




7. Drive one $\frac{1}{4}$ x 1-1/4" Lag screw into pilot hole. Tighten the lag screw.




8. Identify the 7/16" hole located on right side of Rafter U-channel. Drill a 3/32"x 1-1/4" pilot hole at the center of the 7/16" hole.




9. Drive a ¼" x 1-1/4" Lag Screw into the pilot hole. Tighten Lag Screw.




10. Flip the assembly over again. Drill a 3/32" x 1-1/4" pilot hole through the hole in the "Straight Cut Stop" face and into the straight cut edge of the rafer member



11. Drive one $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1-1/4" lag screw into the pilot hole you drilled. Tighten the lag screw.




12. Identify the rafter U-channel on the opposite side of the rafter member you have installed on the Octagon Spider Bracket.



13. Repeat steps 1-11 to add a second rafter member with cross ties and roof skirt bracket to the opposing U-channel.


The Starter Rafters Assembly should appear as shown, below.




3.2 INSTALLING THE STARTER RAFTERS ASSEMBLY

Two people are needed to lift the Starter Rafters Assembly and place it inside two opposing post top rafter tie brackets. It does no matter which opposing corners you start at.


1. The Starter Rafters Assembly will be very stiff and solid. Lift the Starter Rafters Assembly and place the rafters inside the open U-channels in the post top rafter ties.




2. Measure the overhang on both sides. Center the Starter Rafters Assembly between the two corners by sliding it until the overhangs on both sides are equal.



3. Drill 3/32" x 1-1/4" pilot holes at the center of four holes each in both post top rafter tie brackets.




4. Drive ¼" x 1-1/4" lag screws into all pilot holes you drilled. Tighten the lag screws. Post Top Rafter Tie has holes on both sides of the rafter. Drive screws through holes on both sides of the rafter.



3.3 INSTALLING ALL RAFTERS, ITEM A

Obtain a step ladder. The step ladder will be needed to reach the roof peak octagon spider bracket to secure the remaining rafters.

- 1. First, add two rafters perpendicular to the rafters already installed in the Starter Rafters Assembly along the line.
- 2. Follow rafter installation steps provided in 3.1 to add the rafters along the its designated U-channel and its matching post top rafter tie at the corner posts. Secure the rafter to the Octagon Spider Bracket first. Then follow by securing the rafter to the post top rafter ties.



- 3. Next, add rafters along 2 and 3 arrow lines
- 4. Drive screws to secure rafters to Octagon Spider U-Channels first, then drive screws to secure rafter to Post Top Rafter Ties. Tighten down all lag screws.
